<p>“Staying Alive on the Outside”.</p> <p>This video teaches viewers how to prevent and recognize opioid overdoses, and how to intervene when they happen. Community members candidly discuss the challenges of reentry from prison, opioid addiction and relapse, and misconceptions about opioid tolerance and overdose. Viewers learn strategies to avoid overdose while using opioids, as well as what to do if they witness an overdose.
