



Position Title: Part-Time PRAXIS Trainer

C4 is seeking a Part-Time On Call (PTOC) trainer for the Praxis team with expertise in substance use disorder treatment and training/technical assistance.

Responsibilities:

- Deliver training to providers in BSAS-funded treatment programs, using adult learning principles and interactive strategies.
- Deliver technical assistance on strategies for implementing harm reduction practices and HIV/AIDS, viral hepatitis and opioid overdose prevention education in BSAS-funded treatment programs.
- Conduct needs assessments with individuals and organizations to identify, develop and deliver outcomes-based technical assistance and training.
- Create products including online curricula, toolkits, manuals, user guides, and assorted other training and resource materials, and manage/comply with product deliverable timelines.

Education and Work Experience

- Expertise in teaching/training adult learners in knowledge and skills required for improving work competencies.
- At least 3 years of experience working within a substance use disorder treatment agency as a provider, supervisor, administrator, technical expert, and/or a technical assistance provider.
- Experience working with the Bureau of Substance Abuse Services (BSAS) in Massachusetts is preferred.

- Expertise in the delivery of services and evidence-based practices for the treatment of substance use disorders and working with families and youth in system level service planning and delivery to support recovery.

Other Requirements

- Strong public speaking skills and ability to write, peer review, and publish content-related articles.
- Ability to conceptualize, analyze and follow-through with multiple, competing priorities.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills with ability to lead, facilitate, and participate in collaborative partnerships.
- Excellent computer skills and familiarity with PowerPoint and/or other presentation software.
- Ability to drive/travel to programs throughout the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
